



## THE MIKE SAKATCH JAZZ PROSPECT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES 2020

### **SPECIFIC TO:**

The Mike Sakatch Jazz Prospect Scholarship is an award open to all Alberta International Band Festival high school participants who intend to pursue music at the post-secondary level following high school. The scholarship is **NOT** restricted to grade 12 students.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:**

The Mike Sakatch Jazz Prospect Scholarship is valued at \$500.

### **OVERVIEW:**

It is the intent of the scholarship that the funds offset the expense of post-secondary or extracurricular musical studies and provide the recipient with an extra incentive to continue with their music education. Examples include but are not limited to:

- Post-secondary tuition.
- Private music lessons.
- Attendance at a summer music camp that will enhance their musical development.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

All applicants **MUST** meet the following criteria:

1. Be a resident of Alberta, a current senior high school student, and be a participant in the southern portion of the Alberta International Band Festivals.
2. Completion of Section I through III of the application form.

### **APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS:**

The AIBF Scholarship Selection Committee will screen all applications to ensure the criteria have been met. The successful candidate will be selected by the Jazz Adjudicators based on his/her performance at the Festival. The decision of the Adjudicators will be final.

### **AWARD DISBURSEMENT:**

The successful applicant in the southern portion of the Province of Alberta will be notified by telephone and in writing. A certificate of acknowledgement will be presented to the recipient at the Jazz Showcase Concert for the Alberta International Band Festival in Calgary at 7:00 PM on Friday, March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the TransAlta Performing Arts Studio (1302 – 6<sup>th</sup> Street SE; just north of Calgary Stampede Park).

The scholarship monies will only be granted when the recipient submits proof of enrollment in an acceptable program of study. In all matters concerning the eligibility and payment, the decision of the AIBF Scholarship Committee shall be final.
